Hartford Background

Hartford is located in the heart of the Upper Valley region and consists of five villages (White River Junction, Hartford Village, Wilder, Quechee and West Hartford) and several smaller hamlets. With a population of 10,000 residents, Hartford is the ninth largest community in Vermont.

First chartered in 1761, Hartford has three major rivers (Connecticut, White and Ottauquechee) along with a rich agricultural, railroad, and mill history. White River Junction evolved with the development of the railroad in Hartford between 1848 and 1952. In 1847, the Vermont Central Railway and Connecticut River Railroad began laying track through the village. The first railroad train in Vermont left White River Junction on June 26, 1848, and by the 1890s, White River Junction had become the most important railroad village in northern New England. Rail growth stimulated development throughout the village. Rural character predominated in Hartford Village until 1797, when a dam was built on the White River in Hartford Village. The dam provided power for a sawmill and gristmill, and resulting industry drew settlers to live and work in Hartford. The development of Wilder, located on the banks of the Connecticut River, was likewise spurred by industrial development. As early as 1795, residents utilized power generated by two village waterfalls to operate corn and saw mills in Wilder. Over time, the falls powered a series of mills on the river in Wilder, and hundreds of mill workers settled in the village. Quechee's growth was closely linked with the adjacent Ottauquechee River and the industry that developed on its banks. Early proprietors recognized the potential of the river and, in 1765, voted to grant 600 acres to the river falls as an incentive to draw mill development. In the 1870s, saw and grist mills were established, attracting new residents. West Hartford, the fifth village in Hartford, is the most rural. In the late 18th century, farmers and mill owners settled in West Hartford, and the community grew over time despite catastrophic floods in 1867 and 1927.

Project Objectives

The primary objective of this project is to gather and assemble town-wide survey information/documentation for historic properties located in the town of Hartford that are not already listed on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) or included in the Hartford Barn Census. Provide a preliminary assessment of NRHP eligibility for each property. Enter survey results into the Vermont Division for Historic Preservation (DHP) HSSS database and generate individual survey forms for each property surveyed. This reconnaissance-level survey will form a baseline to inform future historic preservation planning efforts, including possible individual and district NRHP nominations.

Methodology

Liisa Reimann and Sarah LeVaun Graulty, of Blue Brick Preservation, Inc., carried out this project between January and August 2013.

Project Start

Sarah Graulty met with the Hartford Historic Preservation Commission (HHPC) to define project priorities, scope and inventory methodology. The Town provided a list of properties to be included in the survey, as determined by the Hartford Historic Preservation Commission. In addition to the list of properties to be included, the Town also provided copies of the current Historic Sites and Structures Survey, a complete set of E-911 address maps, and a dynamic Google map indicating locations of properties to be included in the survey.

Prior to Fieldwork

Prior to beginning fieldwork, consultant reviewed the existing HSSS and NRHP-listed properties against the list of properties to be surveyed to eliminate duplication. After confirming the property list, consultant assigned HSSS survey numbers to each property. Consultant also obtained a copy of the HSSS database program from the DHP, into which the survey information would be entered and which would be used to generate survey forms. Before beginning fieldwork, consultant entered available metadata, including survey number, address, and property owner, into the database. Assessor files, accessible at <http://www.vgsi.com/vision/Applications/ParcelData/Home.aspx>, provided additional information.

Fieldwork

Consultant surveyed the subject properties between March and August 2013. Site visits were planned utilizing the E-911 address maps and digital Google mapping. Consultant carried hard copies of survey forms to the field and gathered survey information directly on the forms for each property. Consultant made preliminary determination of NRHP eligibility, either individually or within a logical historic district. In addition, consultant captured digital photographs of each subject property.

Database and Survey Forms

Following fieldwork, information collected was entered into the HSSS database. Photographs were linked to each record. Complete survey forms were generated from the database. Survey forms and accompanying photographs were submitted in print and digital formats to the Vermont Division for Historic Preservation and the Town of Hartford.

Results and Recommendations

In total, 399 properties were documented and surveyed, noting baseline information to the extent available through this reconnaissance-level survey. Occasionally, certain details such as foundation roof material were not accessible to the surveyor, typically because wall cladding extended all the way to the ground or a flat roof prevented visual inspection from the ground. In these instances, this inaccessibility was noted on the survey form. Each of the 399 properties was assessed for NRHP eligibility, and the eligibility recommendation was noted on the survey forms. Properties are eligible for listing on the NRHP if they can be shown to have both significance and integrity. Although historic research was outside the scope of this project, significance was considered based on visual observation and an understanding of town development. Greater research will be necessary to fully determine significance. A building is considered to have significance if it:

- A) is associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history;
- B) is associated with the lives of persons significant in our past;
- C) embodies the distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction, represents the work of a master, possesses high artistic values or represents a significant and distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction; or
- D) has yielded, or is likely to yield, information important in prehistory or history.

Integrity is assessed in seven distinct aspects: location, design, materials, workmanship, setting, feeling and association. Properties with greatly diminished integrity, for example those whose original windows, doors and exterior siding have been replaced, would generally be considered ineligible for listing. However, properties being considered collectively as a district, rather than as individual resources, may still be considered eligible for the NRHP despite diminished integrity, if they, as indicated in the 1997 Vermont Historic Preservation Plan “physically and spatially create a significant historic environment.” In such a case, properties’ status as contributing or non-contributing resources would depend upon, among other things, the severity and/or compatibility of changes as well as their continued ability to articulate their historic associations to the surrounding environment.

Of the properties surveyed, 53 properties were identified to have potential individual eligibility. Additional research and survey is recommended for each of these properties. For more information, see the summary table below and details provided on each survey form.

In addition, 18 properties were determined to be potentially eligible within historic districts. It should be noted that even if these properties/ districts are not found to meet the threshold for NRHP listing, they could be placed on a local list of locally significant properties because they offer an important glimpse into Hartford history and development. The potential historic districts identified are:

- **Advent Lane:** Historic recreational/ religious camp property is an excellent candidate for a historic district. Likely eligible under Criteria A and C. Additional research and survey recommended. (#1408-089)
- **Victory Circle:** Intact post-WWI neighborhood has high potential as a historic district. Likely eligible under Criteria A and C. Additional research and survey recommended. (#1408-135, #1408-136, #1408-137, #1408-138, #1408-139, #1408-140, #1408-184, #1408-185)
- **Verna Court:** May constitute a district related to the railroad. Low integrity, but possibly eligible under Criteria A and C. Additional research and survey recommended. (#1408-133, #1408-144)
- **Hartford Avenue:** Possible district of buildings share massing, gable ornament. Maybe eligible under Criterion C. More research needed. (#1408-199, #1408-200, #1408-201)
- **Chandler Road:** Possible district. Maybe eligible under Criterion C. More research needed. (#1408-225, #1408-226)
- **516 Mill Road:** Historic mill may be eligible as a historic district. Likely eligible under Criteria A and C. Additional research and survey recommended. (#1408-337)
- **3020 Old River Road:** Potential district eligibility because of connection to railroad. May have been a workers’ cottage or other relate structure. Possibly eligible under Criteria A and C. More research needed. (#1408-373)

The majority of the properties surveyed were found to be NRHP ineligible. Many of the dwellings were ubiquitous house types and better examples occur elsewhere in the town of Hartford and throughout

the region; as a result, these properties were not sufficiently significant to merit listing. In addition, many properties showed considerable alterations, particularly changes to wall cladding, roof covering, and windows. Additions, fenestration changes, and other alterations were also common. These widespread changes compromised integrity, rendering these properties ineligible for listing. Occasionally, integrity might have been sufficient for listing as part of a historic district, but most often no logical district was apparent or the overall integrity was insufficient. For example, the houses along Lantern Lane present a story of unified development, but the inconsistent integrity of the individual building precludes the possibility of a historic district, and none is a candidate for individual listing. The Queen Anne-era Barnes Avenue development is a similarly unified development whose integrity has eroded so far as to render the collection of houses ineligible for NRHP listing.

Finally, several properties with severely diminished integrity bear mentioning despite their ineligibility for the NRHP. Both 19 Prospect Street (#1408-389, to be demolished shortly) and 17 Maple Street (#1408-141, demolished July/August 2013 after consultant survey) are/were examples of an uncommon building type in Hartford: the early 20th century triple-decker apartment building. Although the architectural details of 17 Maple Street were largely stripped away by the time of the survey (and the building was sub sequentially demolished), 19 Prospect Street retains a number of significant features. It is recommended that the interior of this structure be documented prior to demolition.
